PROGRAMA DE PRE-K

Our fundamental goal is encouraging children to learn and grow by providing a foundation of developmentally appropriate experiences where all children can succeed in a safe and nurturing environment.

The Pre-kindergarten curriculum combines a Constructivist philosophy with a play-based, child centered approach that focuses on building autonomy where students learn to become independent thinkers and make self-governed decisions. Meaningful play encourages curiosity, discovery, and problem solving which allows individual growth and development of a positive self-image. Students have the opportunity to participate in both indoor and outdoor learning experiences through project work and self guided learning which promotes cognitive, social, and physical growth.

We foster a dynamic learning environment where students can participate in projects like Solar Car, STEAM club, VEX Robotics, Drone-3D printing, and many other interactive challenges. These programs enhance the sense of community at Frontier Schools and encourage a hands-on approach to learning.



GIFTED EDUCATION PROGRAM

PROGRAMA DE EDUCACIÓN PARA DOTADOS

Students in grades K-8 that are identified as gifted attend a gifted pull out program three times a week. Students spend time working with a certified gifted teacher in a dedicated and a specifically designed classroom – the "Creativity Garden" – working on interdisciplinary STEM focused projects. Students learn about coding, robotics and scientific inquiry via project based and problem based activities. The gifted teacher also monitors the overall student academic progress and growth via monthly grade checks.

High school students identified for the gifted education program meet with a certified gifted teacher on a monthly basis at STEM High School and a weekly basis at Frontier School of Excellence. Students discuss college and career exploration, counseling and readiness topics in a mentorship style program. Their gifted teacher also monitors the overall student academic progress via monthly "check ins" and counselor collaboration.

HOW TO APPLY

CÓMO APLICAR

The easiest and quickest way to apply is online at frontierschools.org. The application window is November 1st - February 1st, but you can still apply after February 1st. Student must live within the Kansas City Public School District boundaries to apply. For detailed admission information, visit frontierschools.org.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

PREGUNTAS FRECUENTES

Q: Do you charge tuition? / ¿Cobran matrícula?

A: No, Frontier Schools is a tuition free public school. / No, Frontier Schools es una escuela pública gratuita.

Q: Who is eligible for tuition-free Pre-kindergarten program? / ¿Quiénes son elegibles para asistir al Pre-Kinder?

A: The student must be (4) years old on or before September 1, reside within the Kansas City Public School District boundaries, and must be eligible for the National School Lunch Program (determined by completing a Free and Reduced Price School Meals Application). / El estudiante debe tener (4) años de edad para el primero de septiembre o antes, residir dentro de los límites del distrito de escuelas públicas de Kansas City y debe ser elegible para el programa Nacional de Almuerzos Escolares (determinando al completar una solicitud de comidas escolares gratis y de precio reducido).

Q: How old must a child be to attend Kindergarten? / ¿Cuantos años deben tener los niños para asistir al Kinder?

A: A child must be (5) years old on or before September 1 of the school year in which the child applies for entrance. / Los niños deben tener 5 años para el 1ero de Septiembre del año escolar para el cual está aplicando.

Q: Are the students tested to be accepted to the school? / ¿Se les hace examen a los estudiantes para ser aceptados en la escuela?

A: No, since Frontier Schools is an open enrollment charter school, we do not test students as part of the admission process. / No, ya que las Escuelas Frontier son una escuela subvencionada abierta a la inscripción, no hacemos examen a los estudiantes como parte del proceso de admisión.
